Competition rules

1.

The competition is open to organists of all nationalities born after January 1st 1999.

2.

The candidates should submit a program of maximal length 20 minutes of music. The choice of the works is free and should fit the instrument specification and stoplist of the Andrea Zeni organ located in the Sala Bavarese of the Teatro Comunale in Tesero.

A video-recording with a selection of maximal length of 10 minutes should be sent as a youtube link along with the program.

An additional prize for the best original work for organ solo will be assigned on the evening of the prize-winners concert. This piece should have a maximal length of 6 minutes and should be written by the candidate herself/himself and performed on that day. The presentation of an original work is not mandatory and will be judged separately.

3a.

Requested documents for the application:

- Filled out and signed application form.
- Digital copy of an ID
- a concert program of max. 20 minutes length.
- a Youtube link to a video recording of maximum length of 10 minutes without interruptions of one or more of the works included in the program. The works and their length should be specified in the description.
- receipt of the application fee of € 30,00. The fee should be paid to the following bank account:

The registration deadline is July 15th 2025. The application should be sent to the following email address: giuliano.organotesero@outlook.com along with the attachment listed on section 3a.

Based on the performance on the video recording and on the submitted program, the jury will select three prize-winners within August 15th 2025.

Every finalist will receive a prize of € 500,00.

On the day of the prize-winners concert, 2 additional prizes will be assigned:

- Prize for the best original composition of € 200,00, if the candidate decides to include one in the program.
- Audience-prize of € 150,00 (assigned after the performances on September 28th 2025).

The jury's winner's selection is irrevocable.

5.

The prize-winners should perform their program on September 28th 2025 at 5 PM on the Andrea Zeni organ located in the Sala Bavarese of the Teatro Comunale in Tesero.
